Allocations and Targets for this academic year

After a successful year in 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 improving high quality PE and sport provision at Brunton, we will continue to raise achievement for all pupils in sport with the £8900.00 sport premium funding this year.

We have developed an action plan to continue the excellent work developed last year in order for our pupils to benefit from an ongoing legacy of enriched sport, exercise and keeping healthy.

We will aim to:-

- ✚ Work with a specialist PE teacher to continue to guide and support staff in delivering high quality lessons showing clear progression, increase teachers subject knowledge and develop and fine tune a clear assessment procedure for all staff to adopt and follow.
- ✚ Ensure all staff (old and new) take the opportunity to attend CPD training in order to develop high quality PE lessons
- ✚ Continue to develop a Brunton PE scheme of work showing progression from Reception to Year 4 in all subjects
- ✚ Organise 'Bike It' events throughout the year to encourage children to bike and scoot to school.
- ✚ Continue to develop young sport leaders in Key Stage 2 through the 'play leaders' course
- ✚ Increase competition and festival participation for all children by providing transport to and from venues and create strong links with the other first schools in the Gosforth Trust to create more competitions.
- ✚ Continue to monitor and target KS2 boys and girls for extracurricular activities
- ✚ Continue to update and extend the PE equipment so staff can deliver high quality lessons
- ✚ Continue to update and extend playtime equipment so effective 'zoning' can take place.
- ✚ Continue to implement morning and after school clubs to increase high quality PE and sport at Brunton
- ✚ Develop a sporting themed fortnight raising awareness of the different types of sports available to children
