IMAGINATION!


What does it mean to 'imagine' something?

Well, yesterday we were thinking about the word **IMAGINATION**. What did you think it meant?


Well done! Yes, things that you **imagine** are things that are not real. They are things that we make up. They are pictures in your mind - your **imagination**!



1. What was the story all about?
