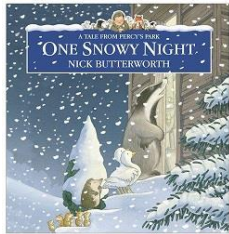
Monday

Is Percy's hut big or little?

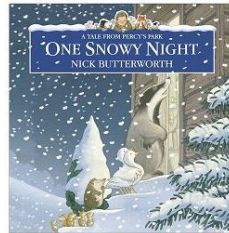
Wednesday

Which part of the story did you like best?

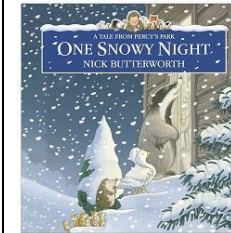
When they all fell out of bed? When they all found a cosy bed to sleep in?
