 Deep peace of Christ, the light of the world to you.



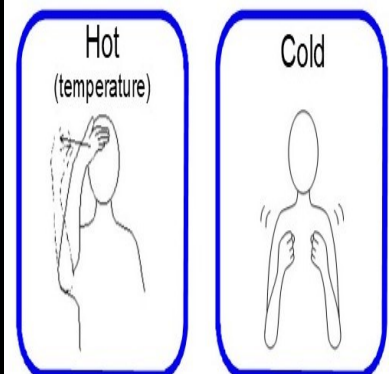

EYFS Tapestry
