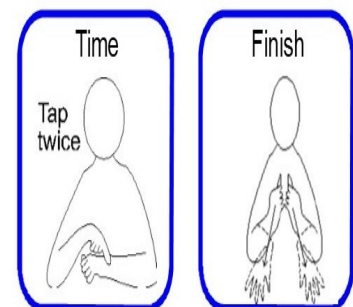

This allows us time to post the applications to the council for you before we break up for half-term on Friday 25th October 2019.
