Reflection Corner



Reporting COVID-19 on Friday 27th November 2020

We would like to remind parents and carers that <u>School is closed to pupils on Friday 27th November 2020</u> as this is a designated training day. Therefore, if you need to report that your child has had a positive test or is self-isolating (because they are a close contact of someone who has tested positive) you must contact the <u>NEAT Central Office</u> on 0191 2284090. This will enable close contacts to be traced before schools re-open on Monday 30 November 2020

Absence Policy

If your child is unwell and unable to come to school, please ring the school office on **0191 2240222** to advise them **before 8.30am**, **each morning** that your child won't be in. Your child's absence may be classed as unauthorised unless you show an appointment slip from the GP surgery or a copy of your child's prescription. Parents of children with attendance lower than 92% will be offered a parent contract in a bid to improve their child's attendance and those falling below 90% may be at risk of a fine. Every day in school counts!

<u>September 2021 - Reception and Year 7 applications now open!</u>

You can now apply for places in Reception Class for September 2021! If you have a child currently in Nursery, or if you know anyone with a child who will turn 4 years old by 31 August 2021, applications for Reception Class 2021 must be made no later than;

12 noon Friday 15th January 2021.

Applications can be made directly online via the Newcastle City Council website, alternatively, you may request a paper application from our School Office that must be returned to us no later than **Thursday 7th January 2021**.
