<p>At Central Walker Primary School, we understand and celebrate the importance of learning another language. Learning Spanish contributes to the children's understanding and respect for other cultures and helps them to gain empathy for how it feels for other children learning English.</p>
<p><b>Intention</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In <b>Key Stage 2</b>, children study the National Curriculum for Languages and, through teaching Spanish, we aim to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Provide an opening to other cultures</li> <li>○ Encourage the children to become inquisitive learners</li> <li>○ Develop children's knowledge of the Spanish language and their knowledge of Spain.</li> <li>○ Enable pupils to express their ideas and thoughts in another language</li> <li>○ Enable pupils to understand and respond to speakers of Spanish, both in speech and in writing</li> <li>○ Provide opportunities for pupils to communicate for practical purposes.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Implementation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All KS2 children receive a weekly Spanish lesson</li> <li>• Lessons build on progression and depth of learning</li> <li>• Lessons link to the Spanish scheme of work, created by the Spanish specialist at Benfield Secondary School</li> <li>• Exciting and engaging lessons</li> <li>• Opportunities to use all areas of language acquisition (speaking, listening, reading and writing,)</li> <li>• CPD to support teacher subject knowledge</li> <li>• Show skills and knowledge through Spanish books and Curriculum floor books</li> </ul>
<p><b>Impact</b></p> <p>By ensuring all of the above we will achieve the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Engaged, inspired and challenged children</li> <li>• Confident and independent linguists</li> <li>• Children who value people from other communities and cultures</li> <li>• A high standard of Spanish in preparation for secondary school</li> </ul> <p>We will measure the impact of our Spanish curriculum through the following methods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A reflection on NC standards achieved against the planned outcomes</li> <li>• A celebration of learning through displays and evidence of work in Curriculum floor books</li> <li>• Pupil discussions about their learning; which includes discussion of their thoughts and ideas, progress of skills and evaluations of their work</li> </ul>
