What can you do if you're not sure what's right? Who do you trust to help you make difficult decisions?

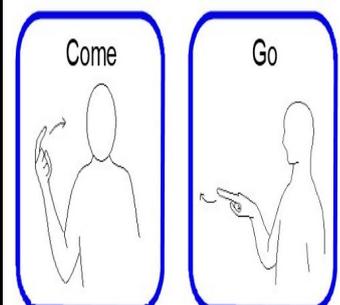
Wellbeing

Headlice

Please can we ask that all our families check their children's hair regularly for Headlice. If your child does have headlice, please treat their hair immediately and **then again every few days for a week or two after**. This is because the headlice eggs hatch in cycles, and if you have missed any headlice or eggs in the first treatment, they may hatch a few days later and the cycle will start again. Treatment can be a specialised Headlice treatment from a pharmacy or thick conditioner used with a Headlice comb. Please be vigilant, check regularly and treat regularly, thank you.
