 Amen.

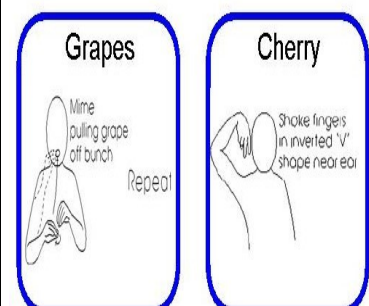
### Wellbeing
