<p>Allocation of funding for 2017-2018 is £18,500 compared to £9050 in 2016-2017. The increase is due to the governments change in allocation from September 2017. New funding based on £16,000 + £10 per pupil on roll compared to old funding of £8000 + £5 per pupil on roll. This change comes into effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 and therefore schools will receive 5/12 of original funding and 7/12 of increased funding.</p>
