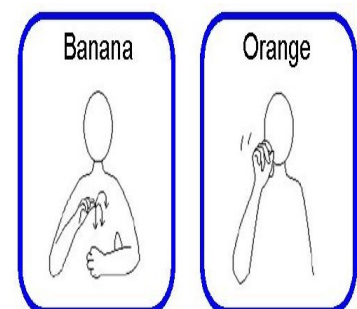


Wellbeing
