Amen.



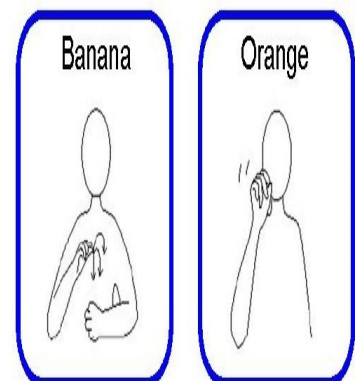
Wellbeing
