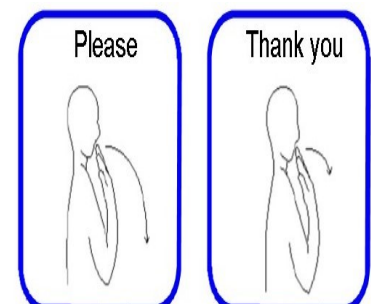
### Harvest Service Wednesday 24.9.19
