



## Collective Worship 2020-21

Aim - To ensure that worship celebrates difference, encourages respect/dignity and raises aspirations. Worship engages creatively with the school's Christian vision and associated values, showing respect for, and giving dignity to all wherever they may be on their spiritual journey.

Monday: <b>Welcome Worship</b>	<u>Whole School</u> Introduction to the theme/value of the week & Picture News (Mrs Day – Virtual)
Tuesday: <b>Reflective Worship</b>	<u>Class</u> - classes in Phase to carry this out at the same time/dim lights/use candle, gentle music etc for reflection/quiet time – where possible ask class worship leader/other children to lead/support Developing spirituality – giving children the opportunity of a silent time to pray and reflect individually and with others. Recap on theme/values introduced on Monday – pose a question for discussion/read a Bible story/watch a video clip etc ... Allow children the opportunity to be still and quiet, helping them to understand that being reflective in their own lives can be helpful. End in prayer – prayer needs to be a natural and valued part of our school culture.
Wednesday: <b>Community Worship</b>	<u>Whole School</u> Led by SLT/Church Leaders/Visitors/Worship Team/Classes (See Worship Timetable – Virtual)
Thursday: <b>Hymn Practice</b>	<u>Whole School</u> Makaton (Led by Mrs Kirtley – Virtual)
Friday: <b>Celebrate &amp; Shine Worship</b>	<u>Whole School</u> Celebrating those children in school who are excellent examples of the value of the week. Shine Awards for children in Reception – Year 6. (Led by Mrs Kerr & Worship Leaders – Virtual)
