
## Tips for Pets on Bonfire Night!

- 1. Keep Pets Indoors**  
Give pets extra exercise during the day and toilet breaks, but keep them in at night.
- 2. Drown Out The Noise**  
Play the radio or put the TV on a little bit louder to muffle firework noises.
- 3. Provide Hiding Spaces**  
Make a special place for pets to hide so they feel snug and secure.
- 4. Identification**  
Make sure your pet is wearing identification incase they run away or get lost.
- 5. Keep Pets Calm**  
Don't punish or fuss over your pet if they are scared. Just stay calm.
- 6. Flashing Lights.**  
Reduce firework flashes by closing the curtains and turning on indoor lights
