1	<p>Painted self-portraits. Make lanterns for Diwali using tissue paper, paint firework pictures, create pictures of fireworks using wax crayons, make Christmas cards and calendars from a variety of materials.</p>		<p>Children will be designing, making, decorating and evaluating individual rockets, after researching different types and styles. Portraits of historical figures, using various materials whilst developing a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space. We will look at how castles were attacked and defended, inviting children to design their own defensive or attacking machinery.</p>		<p>Design and produce a poster relating to the WWII slogans campaigns. Design and make a 'Medal of Honour' relating to good and outstanding work within Farne Primary School. Research, design and build a model of an Anderson Shelter as used by people during the 'Blitz'. Shelter building and team building, children are to construct their own shelter. Continue to look at colour in art. Research warm and cold colours. Blitz pictures. Line drawing.</p>		<p>Study oceans, colours and shapes of the sea, study the artwork of Nicola Bayley in 'The Mousehole Cat'. We will explore a variety of mediums studying sea creatures and plants. We will design divers outfits and research boats so that the children can design their own boats. Water colour and paints.</p>
