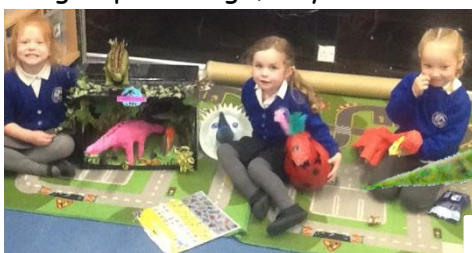
Healthy Fun Day Friday 23rd June

Sunny Weather

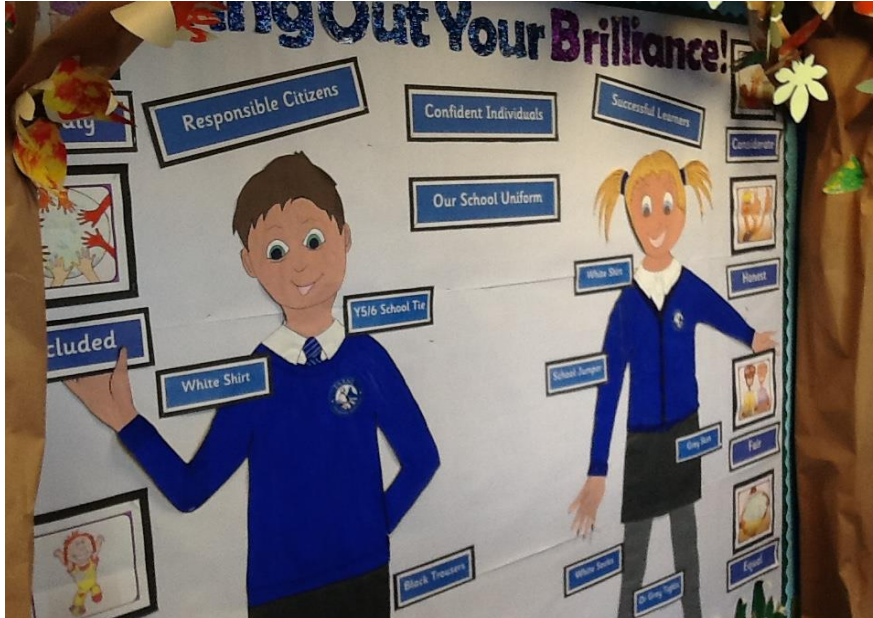
