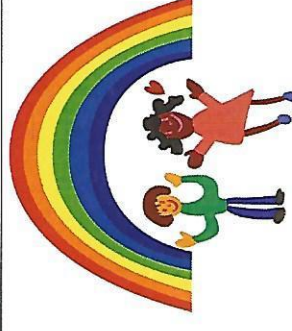
Red Class— We have really enjoyed fruit time and look forward to trying new fruits and vegetables. Pomelo and dragon fruit were new for most of the class!

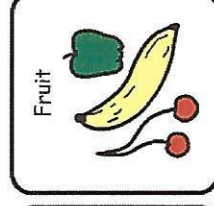
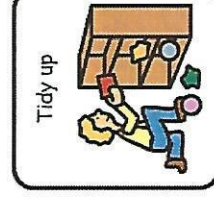
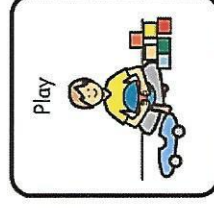

Wednesday 19th December— Special visitor in nursery (listen out for the jingle bells)

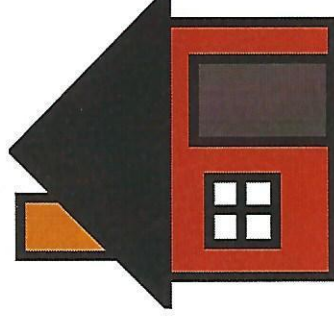
Thursday 20th December—Nursery Party
