

Facebook Protocol



- School's Facebook page is a method of communicating information from school to the school community.
- Speaking to teachers, writing a letter or telephoning the office remain the appropriate methods for parents to communicate with school.
- Verbal abuse or defamatory comments will not be tolerated and will result in a Facebook user being blocked. In more serious cases of defamation, school will seek advice from our legal team. Comments will be removed by school.
- We will only use photographs of children for whom we have consent. This will be sought at the start of every academic year. If you wish to change the consent status for photographs at any time, then please inform the office immediately. In group photographs, children without consent will have their faces blocked out.
- As with current use of photographs, we will never publish a child's name along with their photograph to protect their identity from strangers.
- Pupils of Dordon Primary are below the age limit set by Facebook. Therefore we would not expect to see children liking the page or commenting on posts made by school. This forms part of our work on online safety.
