

What should children wear in school?

Revised uniform list from April 2016

We believe that children should wear uniform in school. We would like children to have pride in being a part of Dordon Primary School and in maintaining a well-dressed and smart appearance. Our uniform has been designed so that much of it is easily obtainable from chain stores.

If your child is unable to wear an item of the uniform temporarily, please let us know by letter. We have never yet sent a child home for being improperly dressed, but we reserve the right to do so. If you are not sure about what is appropriate we would be pleased to talk with you.

Our school has recently changed its uniform and we are now in a transition period. Our smart new navy uniform replaces our former green uniform. To allow parents with new uniform the opportunity to 'wear out' older uniform and not go to unnecessary expense, we are allowing a full year for the new changes to occur. **Our new navy blue uniform is compulsory from April 2017.**



Smart uniform

Girls:

- Black (charcoal/grey is NOT permitted) 'school type' trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore
- White polo shirt
- Dordon sweatshirt or V-necked cardigan with school logo (old style green uniform replaced by April 2017)
- Black school shoes (flat sole/low heels)
- Black/White socks
- Navy Blue check only dresses (Optional-Summer term only) (old style green uniform replaced by April 2017)
- Plain navy blue/black hair band if required

*Please note 'full length buttoned shirts/blouses and Summer fashion shoes e.g. 'flip flops, open toed sandals, canvas shoes etc are **not permitted***

PE

- Black shorts
- Black/white socks
- Plain white round neck T-Shirt
- Plain trainers for outside PE (reception classes summer term only)
- Named 'pump bag'
- Track suit in cold weather (limited logos, black/blue) except reception classes

Swimming

- Plain one piece swimming costume
- Towel
- Swimming hat

EVERY item of uniform MUST be marked with the child's full name

Boys:

- Black (charcoal/grey is NOT permitted) 'school type' trousers or shorts
- White polo shirt (logo not required)
- Dordon sweatshirt with school logo (old style green uniform replaced by April 2017)
- Black school shoes (flat sole/low heels)
- Black/White socks

*Please note 'full length buttoned shirts/blouses and Summer fashion shoes e.g. 'flip flops, open toed sandals, canvas shoes etc are **not permitted***

PE

- Black shorts
- Black/white socks
- Plain white round neck T-Shirt
- Plain trainers for outside PE (reception classes summer term only)
- Named 'pump bag'
- Track suit in cold weather (limited logos, black/blue) except reception classes

Swimming

- Plain swim-trunks (no baggy swim shorts)
- Towel
- Swimming hat

- Jewellery or any make up must not be worn in school at any time.
- We prefer children NOT to wear earrings because of potential for accidents. However, if absolutely necessary, small round 'ball like' silver/gold earring studs may be worn. These MUST be removed for PE/Games or covered with a plaster provided by home.
- Hair for girls and boys which is longer than shoulder length MUST be tied back
- Boots are NOT to be worn in school by children
- Trousers length should not extend beyond the heel
- Extreme hair styles are not permitted. Hair should not be closely shaved and only natural hair colours are permitted
