Covid -19

With cases of the Delta variant rising markedly in Birmingham and the country, we, as a school, have had a small number of positive cases resulting in the year group "bubbles" having to isolate.

We work closely with Public Health England and official guidance is that close contacts of the individuals are required to self-isolate for 10 days.

Individuals, who have tested positive on a Lateral Flow Test, are required to take a PCR test and if that returns negative then the year group "bubble" can return to school.

In the meantime, we continue to provide remote learning for the year groups and teachers are in contact with parents and students.

Remember to wear face masks when on the school site (unless you have a medical exemption) and keep 2 metres space between individuals not in your family "bubble".

Please continue to observe the "hands, face, space, fresh air" message.

Stranger Danger

This morning we had reports of a stranger in a blue Fiesta stopping and offering some of our children a leaflet for an event. Reassuringly the children refused this and informed school. We have informed the Police and given details of the car and a description of the man.

We will reinforce the message to the children of not speaking to or going near strangers but ask that you also speak to your children to warn them of the dangers.
