

Leaving school or moving class?

We understand that moving school can be difficult for a child with SEND and we take steps to ensure that any transition is as smooth as possible.

If your child is moving to another school.

We will contact the new school SENCO and ensure they know about any special arrangements or support the needs to be made for your child. We will make sure that all records about your child are passed on as soon as possible.



When moving classes in school.

Information will be passed on to the new class teacher in advance and in most cases, a planning meeting will take place with the new teacher. All ITP's will be shared with the new teacher.

We currently carry out a programme of activities for children who require additional support with transition and these activities are adapted to meet the individual needs of each child.

In Year 6

Our SENCO will contact the SENCO at your child's secondary school to ensure that information is passed on in advance highlighting the provision your child currently receives within St Wilfrid's.

Your child will take part in focused learning about aspects of transition to support their understanding of the changes ahead, and also complete the transition programme where necessary.

Where possible, your child will visit their new school on several occasions and, in some cases, staff from the new school will visit your child in this school.
