

PARENTS' FORUM 19.05.16

Summary of Matters Raised and Action Points

1. Slow Cooker Course - TD reported that courses are not now available.
2. Workshop - TD reported that she has not found out any more information about this. Mrs Turvey explained that a new PSHE programme is being investigated and this will be started in September, so the workshop is not necessarily needed.
3. Kaye Haywood - Mrs Turvey explained that the new Headteacher had started to meet teachers and would be meeting staff and parents sometime in the future.
4. House beach trip – it was discussed that if there was an end of year trip for the whole school to the beach it might be better to think of a different event for the winning House team.
5. Book swap – Sam Allen ran a session after school and only a few pupils took part, it was suggested that book swap might be better at lunch time. Posters could be created by some pupils to promote this.
6. End of Year Whole School Trip – Cost £900 for coaches, suggested that children should make a contribution and perhaps the PTA could buy the ice-creams.
7. Home School Agreement – It was suggested that it should be shown to Kaye Haywood and her views sought.
8. Class Teachers – Mrs Turvey informed parents that it was not possible to let parents know which teachers would be in each year group, as the school had some teachers leaving and had not yet finished recruiting new ones.
9. Clubs – there was a discussion about having more after school clubs, perhaps invite specialist people in to run these.
10. Young Carers – Beacon Infants have started to investigate the idea of bringing young carers together to support each other and TD wanted to know if this might be something Robartes could look at.
11. Reading Books – It was brought up that parents thought there was a shortage of Accelerated Reader books, Mrs Turvey explained that more have been ordered but might not have been delivered yet.
12. Facebook – ER asked if she could invite the year two parents to join as their pupils would be attending Robartes in September and this was agreed.
