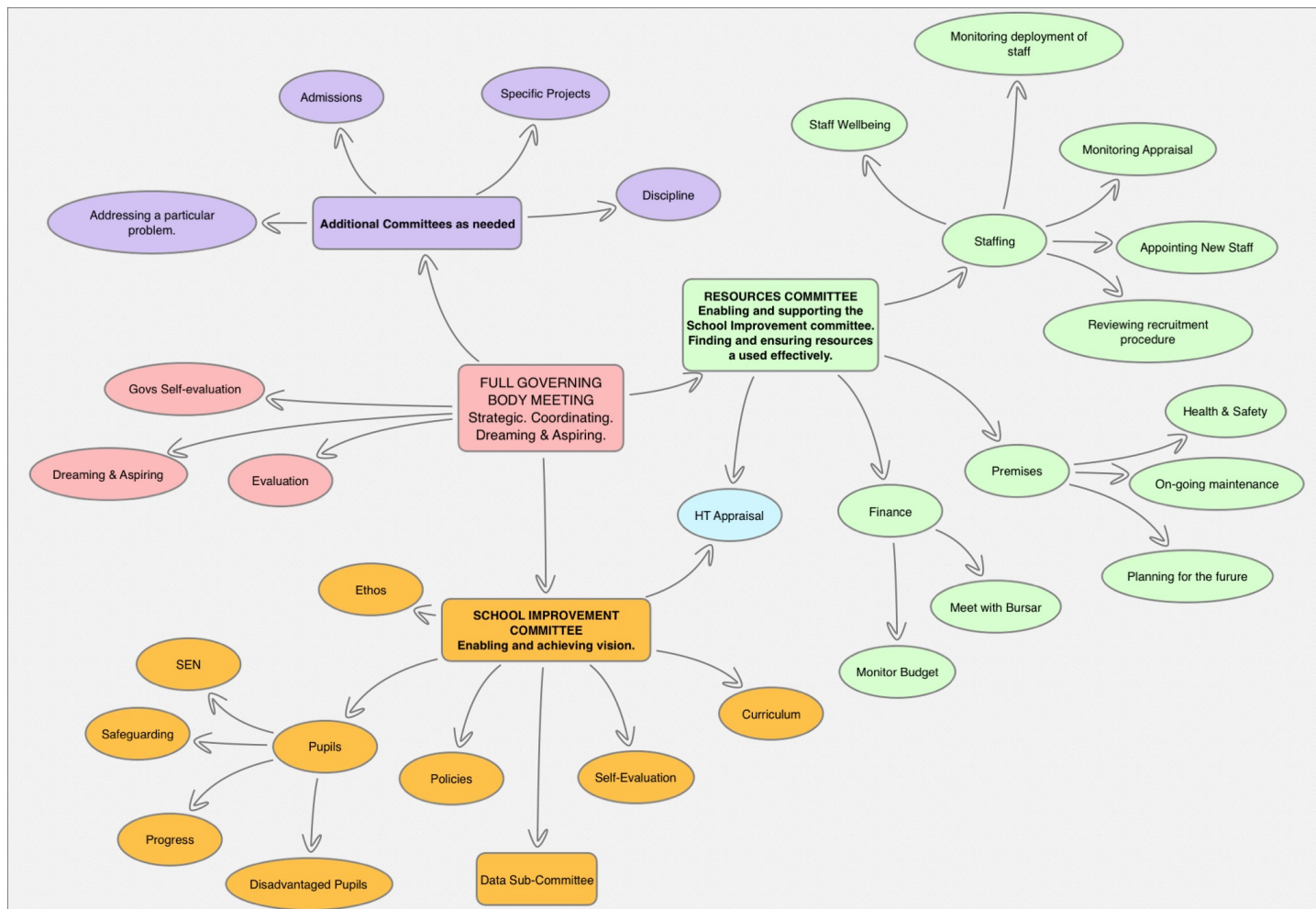


St Nicolas CE Primary School Governing Body Structure



Full Governing Body Meeting – Strategy and coordination. Dreaming and Raising Aspirations. Self-evaluation of Governors. A strategic and coordinating body, setting direction, making sure statutory obligations are met and directing the work of the committees. Full Governing Body Meetings will be used to discuss strategic direction and make use of information and input from the committees, children, parents, staff and other experts to help them arrive at decisions and to prioritise.

School Improvement Committee – Analyse, Review & Monitor. The school improvement committee will review performance and make suggestions for improvements. It will use data and receive reports and briefings from school staff to help inform decision making. The committee will hold school staff to account and note successes.

Resources Committee – Monitor to ensure that the school is making effective and efficient use of resources. The Resources Committee will make sure that resources are used effectively and to support the work of the school.

Headteacher Appraisal Committee - This committee will be made up of three Governors - at least one member from the School Improvement Committee and one from the Resources Committee - one of whom must be the Chair or Vice Chair of Governors.

Much of the 'work plan' is done outside committee meetings by individuals, small groups or sub-committees of Governors meeting with relevant staff or working on their own. Sub-committees or groups are flexible depending on needs and current priorities. Committee meetings are used for reporting back, summarising progress and planning next steps.
