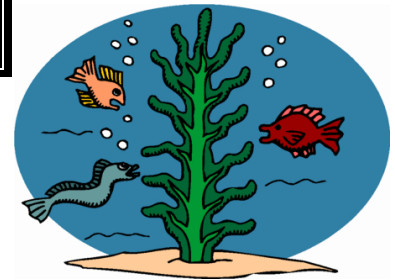

### In The Net

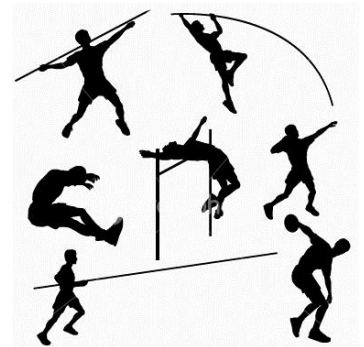
