

Pass the Peas, Please

A game for two or more players.

You will need: a plastic cup, dried peas, game board, paper and pencil.



To play the game.

Each player begins by writing a chosen number on their score sheet e.g. 30.

Place a dried pea into a plastic cup. Roll the pea onto the game board.

Take the number away from 30 and record the remainder.

Next player takes a turn.

In the following turns that player takes the number away from the new remaining number.

The first player to reach zero wins.

The player can be changed by:

- Altering the starting number from 30 to 50 or ...
- Rolling 2 peas, adding the two numbers the peas land on, then taking the sum away from the new remaining number.
- Rolling 2 peas, subtracting the one number from the other, and taking the sum away from the new remaining number.
- Change the board.

What is the effect of changing the rules?

Game board:
