New parent/carers will have received a text and email from Eduspot (School Money) on how to access your online secure booking system for your child. This has been sent to the Primary contact details provided on your child's registration form. If you have not received your link please let the school office know and we will check we have your correct contact details.

We are a cashless school and we use an online platform called School Money to collect secure online payments for breakfast and afterschool club, school trips and other school activities. We ask that payments are made via this system rather than sending cash or cheques into school. We are registered to accept childcare vouchers.
