

Procedures which will be followed when a child is making the right or wrong choices.

Rewards

At St Pius X Primary school, we place great emphasis on an effective reward system which recognises and encourages good behaviour. Children who make the right choices will be recognised by

- Name on the board under the ticks
- Verbal praise
- Visit to another teacher to share good news
- Award Stickers and certificates
- Increased responsibility, privileges
- Class / House Points / reward tokens (all staff included)
- Weekly class certificate
- Headteacher's Award (sticker and / or certificate)

Procedures which will be followed

Verbal reprimand and explanation of what is expected.

If behaviour continues then a further verbal reprimand and warning that if the behaviour continues the child's name will be on the board.

Name on the board under the cross

Entry into class incident book.

Teacher speaks to the parent/carer, where possible, at the end of the day.

If a pupil has three or more of the previous stages in a week a meeting with parents to be convened.

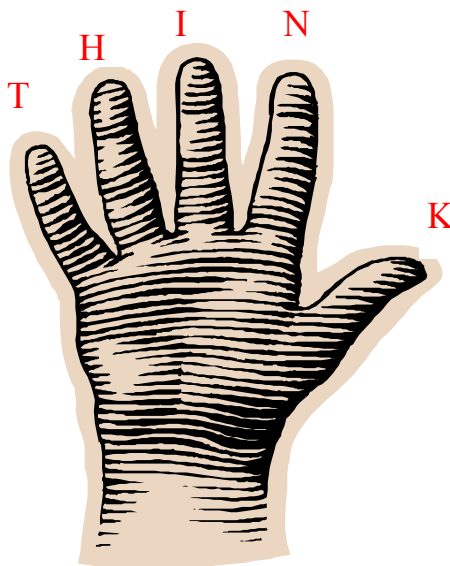
Meeting to be repeated if necessary.

Target setting for individual child.

If behaviour continues or individual incident of behaviour covered by the national standard list of reasons for exclusions

Temporary (fixed term) exclusion in accordance with guidelines to schools.

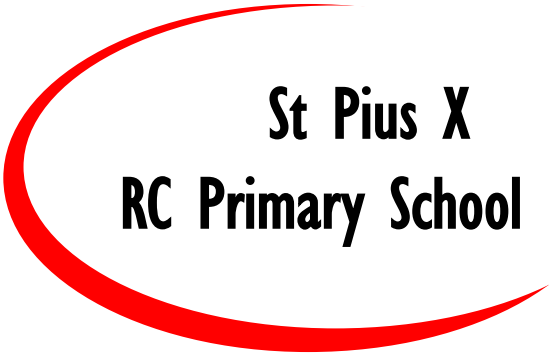
Permanent exclusion in accordance with guidelines to schools.

Positive Promotion Of Good Behaviour

It is essential to praise and encourage children to behave well. Not just on one occasion, but continually. A whole variety of methods are used—stickers, points, certificates awarded at assembly, sharing good work with the Deputy Headteacher or Headteacher, verbal praise, are just some examples. Various strategies for encouraging good behaviour are used at St Pius X. Good work certificates are awarded to children who make great efforts in and out of class. These certificates are awarded at our weekly Certificate Assembly.

At St Pius X RC Primary School we value the importance of good behaviour.

As children of God, we need to try and make the right choices, which are true to the Gospel values we hold so dear.

We want our children to be good citizens both in our school and the wider community.

Alongside each class and their individual rules, we have devised some simple but important rules to help our children to behave in an appropriate manner.

We have used the target words **THINK** and **SAFE** to help them to remember these important rules.

PLAYGROUND RULES

Stop playing when the whistle goes.

And walk to your class line.

For class points, wait quietly.

Everybody walk safely into class.

Points will be awarded by the adults on playground duty for each class.

SCHOOL RULES

Tell the truth.

Have respect for yourself, others and school equipment.

I will always listen and take turns.

Nice words and actions.

Keeep safe and walk.

Children who help to keep the school rules will be acknowledged during assemblies and by class teachers. However, children who fail to keep the rules will face the following sanctions.
