Scarlett Thomas Author Visit:

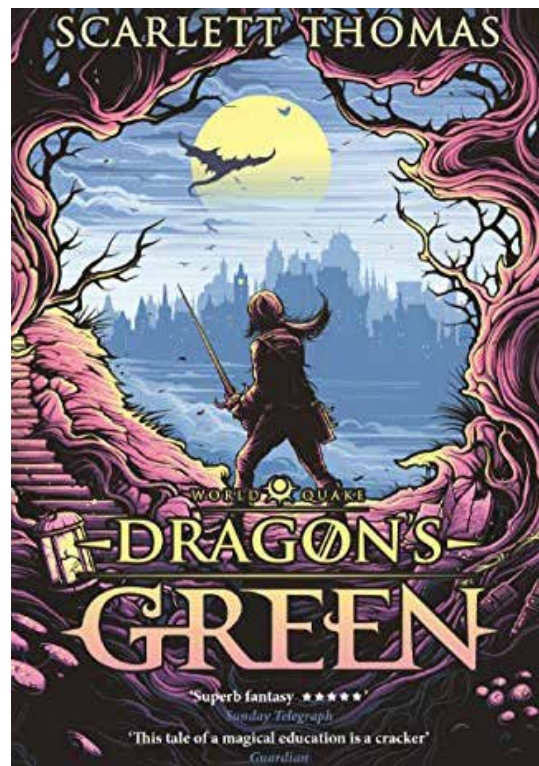
Today Years 4,5 and 6 were treated to a book reading by Scarlett Thomas the author of Dragon's Green.

Scarlett Thomas, a professor in Creative Writing at the University of Kent, talked about her new book, Dragon's Green.

She focused on creative writing and using imagination to create worlds and characters in our own stories. Scarlett also talked about her own writing process, and include interactive elements and creative exercises to inspire the children with their own work. Dragon's Green is the first in a series of books, featuring an exciting, magical adventure:

Effie Truelove is a pupil at the Tusitala School for the Gifted, Troubled and Strange. Her grandfather's magical book collection is coveted by shady book-collector, Leonard Levar, and despite Effie's best efforts to protect the precious library, the books are stolen and Effie must embark on the most dangerous adventure of her life...

Packed with evil publishers and ominous booksellers, magical worlds and secret powers, new friends and discoveries, Dragon's Green was a fantastic listening experience for the children and they were very inspired by Scarlett.
