Start of Term Reminders



Please read the points below to ensure the care, safety and well-being of our school community:

Contact details:

Please ensure that you have notified the school office if any of your contact details have changed; it is crucial that we are able to contact someone for your child if we need to.

Medical Information:

If your child requires an asthma inhaler in school please check that it is still in date. Please notify the school office if you have new medical information. If your child requires medicine you must take it to the school office and complete and sign an information form.

Uniform and P.E kit:

The children look very smart in their uniforms; please ensure all items are named so if lost they can be found and returned.

Appropriate school shoes should be worn, colourful trainers and boots are not acceptable.

Hair bands and accessories should be discreet and appropriate for school; no big colourful bows please

P.E kit should be in school at all times. P.E kit is mandatory and consists of a navy blue P.E T shirt with Christ Church School logo, navy blue P.E hoody with Christ Church School logo and plain navy blue shorts, skirts or tracksuit bottoms. Christ Church hoodies are for P.E only and should not be worn as normal uniform. It is expected that all children participate in P.E lessons - if for any reason your child is unable to do P.E, a letter must be given to the class teacher.

Food:

Children may bring a healthy snack for morning break; a piece of fruit, rice cakes, cereal barck
We strive to be a nut-free school to support our children with severe allergies.

Water only please as a classroom drink.

Safety around our school site:

Under no circumstances is it acceptable to park on the zig-zag markings at our school entrance - this space is to ensure clear visibility for our children crossing the road.

The school carpark is for school staff and visitors only. Please do not drive into the car park for Shine drop off or pick up as this puts children exiting from Shine at risk.

Children and adults should dismount bikes, scooters and skateboards and carry/ push them in the playground.

Before and after school, children are the responsibility of their parents and should be supervised on the play equipment. The playground should be clear by 3.30pm when the gates will be locked.

Lateness:

If you are late and arrive after 8.55am, please take children to the school office to be signed in.

Absence:

If a child is absent, please phone the school office between 8.30 to 9.00 am; if you have a planned absence, please fill in a yellow form and hand in to the school office. Please note that all holidays in term time are un-authorised.

Access to the school office is via the main front entrance; adults are not permitted through the classrooms. If you are coming in to help, please sign in at the school office where they can give you a visitors badge which must be displayed at all times. If you are a new parent keen to help regularly, please talk to the school office about a DBS check.

School dinners:

Please remember to prebook all school meals via ParentPay. Even if your child is entitled to UIFSM they do still need to be prebooked. If for any reason there is a change to your child's school meal / packed lunch then the school office can amend this for you as long as you contact them before 9.30am on the morning of the request.

Home School agreement:

The Annual Home School Agreement will be coming home in book bags today. Please read this and sign and return to your child's teacher by Fri 15th September. Please note that annual agreements do include new information and it is important to read them with your children and return them to us annually. Thank you.
