Year 1 Spider Workshop

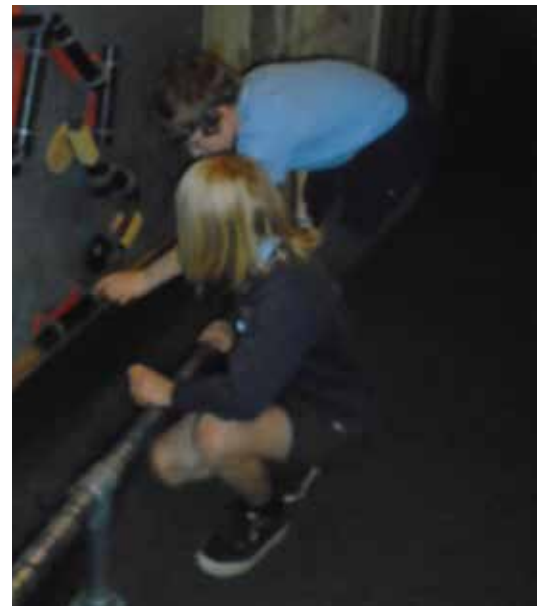
On Friday 6th October 1ZH walked up to The Downs to take part in a spider workshop hosted by the Avon Gorge and Downs Wildlife Project. We learnt about the different parts of a spider's body, the difference between arachnids and insects, how spiders can shed their skin when they grow and how spiders build their webs to catch their prey. Afterwards we went spider hunting armed with an identification guide, some water to spray on the webs (this makes them easier to see!) and magnifying glasses. We were in luck and found a variety of spiders and there was no shrieking from children or adults involved - hurrah! We returned back to school armed with spider knowledge and wrote some interesting spider facts as part of our English work.



Yr 5 Trip to We, The Curious



Last Friday, Year 5 had an out of this world experience at the newly named We The Curious. Walking down Park Street, we were excited about the day and what we would learn in our Earth, Moon and Sun workshop. The workshop was fantastic and we got to learn about how big the planets are in comparison to the earth, how big (or rather how small) the sun is in comparison to some other stars in the galaxy. We tried to guess the size and location of the moon by blowing up balloons and placing them where we thought they should be in comparison to the earth. We were all surprised to learn that the moon is a lot smaller and further away than we thought. Finally, we thought about what would happen to astronauts in space if they didn't have a space suit on...it didn't end well for the marshmallow astronaut! An astronomical thanks to the parents who came with us – some had almost as much fun as we did exploring the exhibits at We The Curious!

From the School Office:

Head Lice

We have had a number of cases of head lice reported throughout the school. Please could you take note of the following advice and help us to eradicate the problem!

CHECK

Your child's hair once a week. Use a proper detection comb to trap head lice. If you find live lice, consult a pharmacist for treatment advice immediately. If head lice are spotted, take a close look at the hair of all the family.

TREAT

Please treat your child with a clinically proven treatment. Leave the treatment on for the recommended time for maximum efficiency. Repeat the treatment for a second time seven days after the original treatment to kill any eggs that may hatch after the first treatment. Check that all head lice have gone within two to three days of the final application of head lice treatment to complete the process. Continue to check for head lice on a regular, weekly basis.
