## Christ Church CE Primary Newsletter 7: 20th October 2017

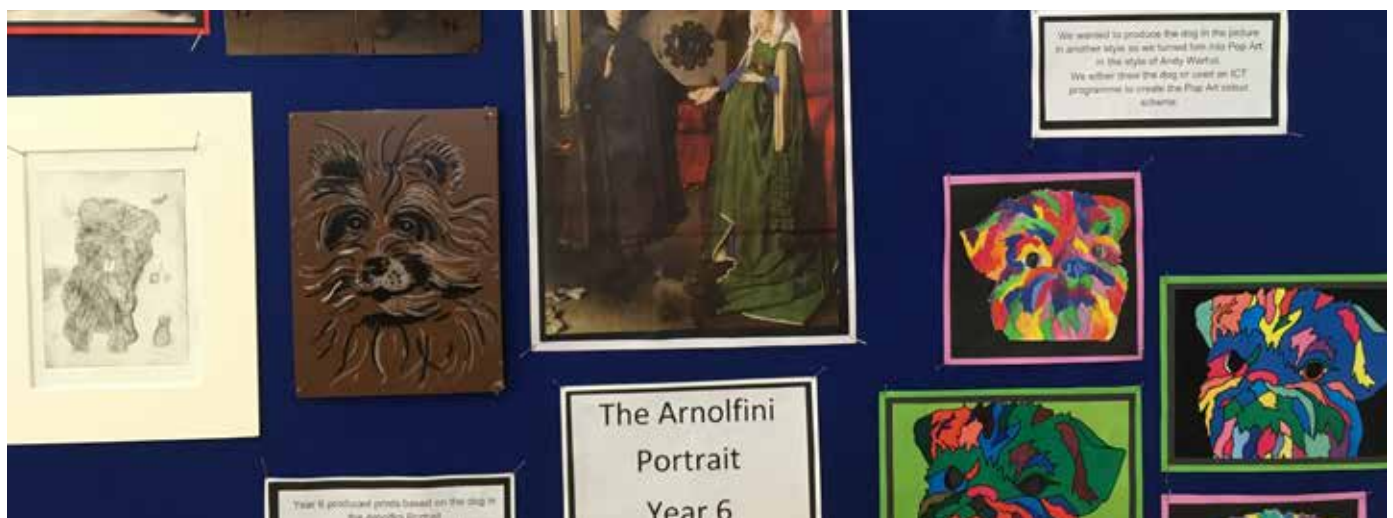
### Message from Mrs Jones:

## Children in Need

50th Anniversary of Disney's The Jungle Book film

On Friday 17th November we are going to be celebrating the 50th Anniversary of The Jungle Book film. We would like the children to come to school dressed as a character from the classic Disney film.
