Some of the class have been so inspired by the story that they have even made their own 'Iron Man'.

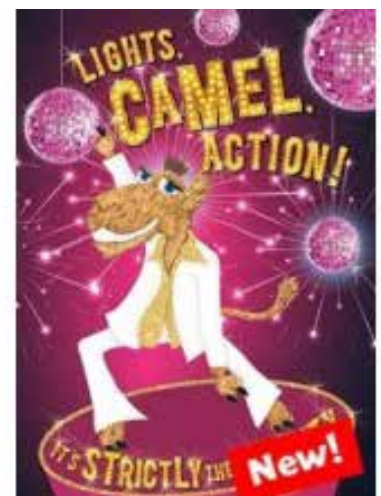


Reception and Key Stage 1 Christmas Plays
