Dear parents, carers and children in Reception,

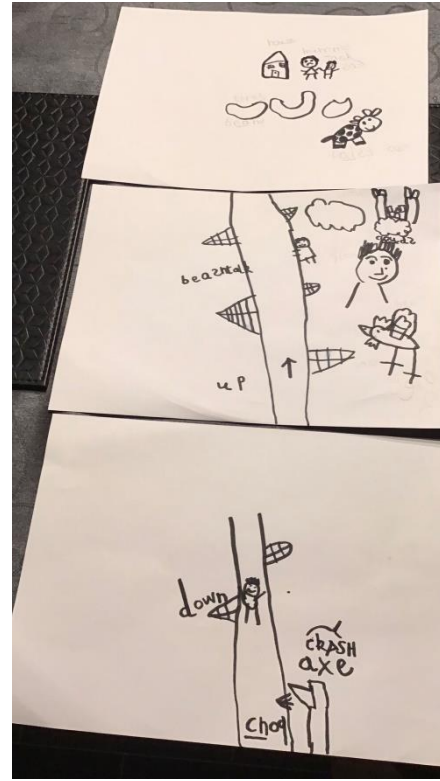
