Non-negotiables

Reading

Read or share a book everyday for 20 minutes. 5 minutes of this time should be discussion with an adult.

Spellings will be fortnightly

The spellings rule sheet will be given out on a Friday. Children will practise the rule and write sentences during week 1 and be quizzed on the rule at the end of week 2.

Maths

You will be set weekly online **Mathletics** homework. This will be based on the learning in the classroom.

Learning opportunities

Please choose one activity each week to complete.

This half term, all homework activities you complete must be photographed and uploaded onto Purple Mash.

In maths we will be learning about measurements. Follow a recipe, weighing and measuring all of the ingredients yourself. Take photos of yourself in action and of your final product.

We are learning about local environmental changes. Create a fact file about HS2 and its impact on our local area.

We have learnt that electricity can be either mains electricity or battery powered. Show me you understand the importance of staying safe around electricity by designing a poster of the important facts.

Write a description about a character from a book that you have read. Write a paragraph about their appearance, their personality and their family.

Continuing with our science theme of electricity, design a new electrical appliance that would make life easier. Think of a problem that needs solving and an electrical appliance that could be used to solve it. Draw or make your own new appliance and label it to show how it works.

Create a leaflet/brochure about visiting a city in the United Kingdom. Think about location, climate, physical and human geography features. Include both writing and pictures.

Write a diary entry for one day of your week. Write the time in numbers **and** in words for each thing that you do.

What famous landmarks does your local town have? Visit Buckingham and take photographs of as many interesting places as you can find e.g twisted chimney, Golden Swan.

Find out the Roman numerals 1-10. Use them to write your number bond facts up to 20, e.g. $11 + 9 = 20$
