Thank you to those parents who have returned the Well Being questionnaire. We had 91 responses. We have analysed the responses (see below) and are able to support those children who have anxieties as they begin the return to school. Relevant staff know who the individual children are who need extra support and will endeavour to help them manage their anxieties as they return to the classroom.

How anxious is your child about returning to school?

43 children are not at all anxious.

38 children are slightly anxious but looking forward to seeing friends.

8 children seem to be rather worried and concerned about some aspects.

2 children are really anxious and not looking forward to returning to school.

How often has your child had negative feelings about going to school, or nervous of something related to school?

44 children have no negative feelings at all.

37 children have mentioned a few negative feelings but no major concerns.

10 children have been negative about school on a number of occasions.

Do you think your child would rather be at home with you instead of returning to school?

39 children said yes.

52 children said no.

During the school closure period what would you say your child has spent most of their time participating in?

34 children engaged in physical/enjoyable activities e.g. visiting the park, football, riding their bike.

31 children spending time online.

17 children other activities.

9 children engaging in fun activities with others.

During the time has been closed has your child had contact with school friends?

68 children have had contact.

23 children have not had contact.

When you talk about returning to school has your child expressed any of the following?

Scared – 10 children.

Nervous – 34 children.

Excited – 44 children.

Happy – 47 children.

Relaxed – 25 children.

How often has your child engaged in work that has been set for them, during the time school has been closed?

Always – 45 children.

Usually – 25 children.

Sometimes – 15 children.

Rarely – 6 children.

Never – 0 children.
