United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child

The Rights that we are exploring in June are:

Article 6 – Every child has the right to life

Article 22 – If a child is a refugee or seeking refuge, governments must ensure that they have the same rights as any other child.

Article 27 – Every child has the right to a standard of living that is good enough to meet their physical, social and mental needs

Article 32 – Governments must protect children from work that is dangerous or might harm their health or education

Article 36 – Governments must protect children from all forms of exploitation that might harm them
