YEAR 6 STONE FARM RESIDENTIAL TRIP

We are delighted to inform you that for this year's Year 6 residential trip we are once again going to be staying at Stone Farm in Devon. This will be the fourth year we have run the trip to Stone Farm and each time it has been a wonderful experience. Stone Farm, set amidst the rolling hills of Dartmoor, is a fantastic environment. It is a working farm but is set up to cater for school children who come to experience life on a farm as well as taking the opportunity to visit other local attractions during the day.

We will be departing from school on **Monday 15th July** and returning on **Friday 19th July 2019**. Planned events that will take place during the week are:

- Hiking on Dartmoor
- Afternoon on the beach
- Swimming
- Otter Sanctuary
- Falconry display
- Morwellham Quay – a fantastic open air museum with stacks of amazing activities for the children to participate in

We'll also be having bonfires, toasting marshmallows and of course there are the jobs on the farm: grooming the pony, feeding the pigs, caring for the birds of prey, looking after the guinea pigs, throwing balls for Diesel the farm-dog and much more.

The total cost of the trip will be £275. This cost is based on 40 children taking a place. The price includes coach hire, accommodation, food and entrance charges. **To book your child's place please pay a £75 non-refundable deposit on WisePay by Monday 15th October and return the slip overleaf.** The balance can be paid in full in December or in instalments as shown:

Start of December- £50
Start of January- £50
Start of February - £50
Start of March - £50

The deposit and slip must be returned by the date above in order to secure your child a place. Failure to keep instalments up to date will result in your child's place being withdrawn.
