### STONEHENGE TRIP

As a part of our history work this term, we have organised a trip for years 3 and 4 to visit Stonehenge. During our visit, the children will become archaeologists and discover Stonehenge through a variety of models and artefacts to answer key questions about the past. This will be followed by hands-on activities at the Neolithic houses from fence building to rope making led by staff from the English Heritage Education team. The children will also have the opportunity to walk around the stones.

We will leave school at 9am and return before the end of the school day. Therefore, children will need a packed lunch, a snack and plenty to drink. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided.

The children will need to wear their school uniform with a warm winter coat, hats, gloves and scarves. All children will need to wear sturdy footwear.

We are splitting the department into 2 groups, visiting on either Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> February or Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February.

Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> February: Italy class and half of Spain class.

Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February: UK class and the other half of Spain class.

**(Spain class, please note the date your child is visiting is highlighted on this letter).**

The cost of the trip is **£7.50** which includes transport and a 2 hour workshop led by English Heritage staff. The children **will not** require any further money to spend on the day.
