Heamoor Code of Conduct

The purpose of our Code of Conduct is to offer guidance to our pupils in managing and modifying their behaviour throughout the school on a daily basis.

8. All children will move slowly and sensibly around the school.
9. All children will be patient and tolerant towards others. Bad language or violence are not allowed or tolerated.
10. All children will support our "High 5" approach to maintain a happy school environment. Bullying is not allowed or tolerated.
11. All children will strive to be independent learners, actively engaged in their own learning and development.

There is an expectation that parents will support their child to comply with our Code of Conduct.
