














We would therefore like to remind you that using Facebook, Twitter and other social networking sites is not the correct forum if you have issues or concerns about the school, staff or pupils as any negative remarks on these sites can be seen as defamation of character, harassment or slander, which means that you could be prosecuted by the police. If at any time you have an issue, your first port of call should be the class teacher. If it remains unresolved then contact the Headteacher. If you are still dissatisfied then you should put your complaint, in writing, to the Chair of Governors.

May we also take this opportunity to remind you that in line with school policy, it is not acceptable to upload photographs or video clips of your child taken at school, which include other children, onto social networking sites without the permission of their parents.

We hope you understand and appreciate our position on such matters and that you will support us by removing any comments of this kind. *Safeguarding our children is our highest priority and we are looking to maintain the strong relationship that we have with parents in order to work together on this issue.*
