We will go to the hall to eat our lunch.

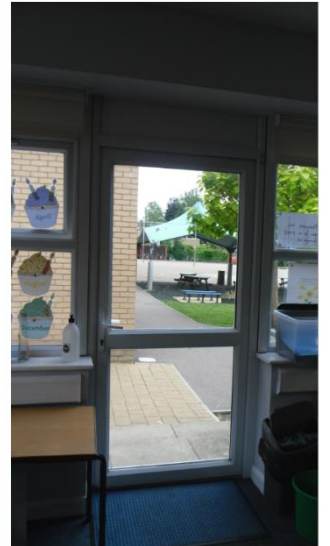
The lunchtime supervisors help us at lunchtimes.
