



Hot Chocolate Club!

Nursery Starters - September 2021

We are delighted to inform you that we are now able to enrol children into our nursery sessions starting in September 2021.

Providing opportunities for our young children to socialise over the last 12 months has been extremely challenging and our children have missed out on many opportunities for this.

Socialising and mixing with friends and other adults form a key part of the early development for children. It allows them to explore and develop language and communication skills, supports them in building relationships and allows them to gain all the skills required to enter school as a confident and independent learner.

Our long-established nursery provision is led by experienced members of staff who can support your child in their early pre-school education. We are able to accept both 15 hour and 30 hour funded pupils and the office staff are very willing to discuss this with you. Please share this with any friends or family members who may be interested in joining our Biscovey family.

Pick up and drop off (following Government guidance)

CAN WE PLEASE REMIND PARENTS THAT CHILDREN WAITING TO ENTER SCHOOL IN THE MORNINGS SHOULD TRY TO ARRIVE AT THE CORRECT TIME FOR THEIR YEAR GROUP. THIS WEEK CHILDREN HAVE ENTERED THE SCHOOL GROUNDS UP TO 15 MINS EARLY AND ALTHOUGH WE ARE PLEASED TO SEE THEM, THESE STAGGERED TIMINGS ARE DESIGNED TO KEEP EVERYONE AS SAFE AS POSSIBLE. Thank you.

- **One parent per family** to drop off/ collect
- Please do stick to your drop off and collection time, it will ensure that there's a steady flow of people on site to avoid unnecessary crowding.
- For collection, the gates will be open at 14:55. Parents are asked not to arrive before 14:55 as this would result in congestion. To support the safe environment, **parents must adhere** to the collection and drop off times.
