



Sport Premium Statement - Albourne CE Primary School 2014-2015

The Sport Premium is an allocation of additional funding from the Department of Education, given to every school with primary age children to support the development of Physical Education, School Sport and Competition. This money is ring-fence and is due to be provided for next three academic years.

All schools are required to report on the amount of funding received and how this is being used, as well as the impact this is having on pupils.

For 2014-2015, Albourne CofE Primary School is due an allocation of around £9000.

For 2014-2015, this money will be used as follows:
