

IS IT A QUESTION OF SPORT?

English

Children will learn story telling skills, including strategies to remember, sequence and use expression. These skills will be used to help children create their own stories, including the use of a range of spelling, punctuations and grammar.

Children will enjoy reading and listening to a range of poetry which is relevant and engaging to them. Using their own ideas, emotions and experience, children will create their own class poem.

FS- Will engage in a different book each week, chosen by them. They will listen, retell, explore characters, act and write about them.
