

## **Year Groups, their host countries and religions to be taught**

### **Foundation Stage – British Isles – Christian and Cornish Festivals**

Experience of other Religious Festivals – Chinese New Year / Diwali linked to Bonfire Night

### **Key Stage 1**

Year 1 – France – Christianity, Kernewek and Judaism

Year 2 – India – Christianity, Kernewek and Hinduism

Buddhism isn't covered in KS1 and is the 4<sup>th</sup> predominant religion in the World. So I feel it is important to teach it in KS2 alongside the other PoS religions

### **Key Stage 2**

Year 3 – Peru – Christianity, Kernewek, Buddhism (50,000+)

Year 4 – Australia – Christianity, Kernewek and Islam

Year 5 – America – Christianity, Kernewek, Judaism and Sikhism

Year 6 – Nepal – Christianity, Kernewek, Buddhism (founded in Nepal) and Hinduism

Buddhism has more followers in Peru than the other PoS religions in KS2 so it is going to be introduced in Year 3.

Buddhism was founded in Nepal and followers share a lot of temples and deities with Hindus. Year 6 are therefore going to cover both religions.
