

PERSONAL KIT LIST Please pack everything in a holdall clearly labelled with name, school and class

All items that are brought on camp must be clearly labelled with a name please

In holdall:

- Trainers (old – that maybe wet all week!) for water sports / water activities
- Shoes or boots with small heel for pony trekking (not trainers)
- Slippers (small as possible and not slipper socks please!)
- Nightwear
- Towel for washing and showering
- Toiletries
- Daily change of underwear and socks
- Trousers / tracksuit bottoms (NOT JEANS as very uncomfortable when wet)
- Shorts
- Tee shirts / polo shirts
- A warm sweater
- Two black bin liners for dirty clothes (labelled with child's name)
- A list of what is in your bag! (taped to the inside lid)
- Swimwear with a swimming towel separate from the washing towel
- Torch (for the night walk)

In your backpack (This goes on the bus with you)

- Packed lunch for 1st day (in a carrier bag that can be thrown away)
- Snap top or screw top beaker/bottle with drink in (check for leaks and wrap in plastic anyway!)
- Sun hat / woolly hat (school hats are ideal!), sunglasses, sun cream, lip salve,
- Insect spray (not compulsory but if you wish it must be a childrens versions and strictly deet free)
- Camera (N.B. if you want to take one this will be solely your responsibility, ideally disposable!)
- Plastic carrier bag in case of mishaps or muddy shoes!
- A couple of plasters in case of blisters
- A small packet of tissues
- A pair of shorts or track suit bottoms (the opposite of what you're wearing)
- Waterproof trousers – need to be 100% waterproof (ESSENTIAL)
- NO SWEETS OR MEDICINES (inhalers only) - any found will be removed!
- Named purse/wallet with up to £5.00 to spend (please do not send more than this!)

Wear on the first day:

- Trainers for games / activities (that are suitable for walking on the moorland)
- A pair of shorts or tracksuit bottoms (the opposite of what's in your bag!)
- A school sweatshirt
- Waterproof jacket - needs to be 100% waterproof! (ESSENTIAL)

Remember that you are representing our school and so dress appropriately. Smart, casual wear is fine. You must wear a school sweatshirt, if you do not have one we will arrange to borrow one for you! No bright slogans or pictures which may cause offence. Be practical!
