

Year 3 Porthpean Camp Kit List - June 2019

PERSONAL KIT LIST Please help your child to pack everything in a **holdall** (not suitcase) clearly labelled with their name. They need to be able to recognise and pack their own things for coming home! If at all possible, PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.

In holdall:

- Trainers for games / activities
- Trainers (old) or beach shoes for watersports (wetsuit boots/shoes are perfect)
- Waterproof trousers -need to be 100% waterproof! (ESSENTIAL)
- Nightwear, towel, toilet requisites
- Daily change of underwear and socks
- Trousers / tracksuit bottoms (not denim jeans as these are uncomfortable if they get wet)
- Shorts
- T- shirts / Polo-shirts
- A warm sweater
- Two black bin liners for dirty clothes and bedding
- A list of what is in your bag! (taped to inside lid)
- Swimwear with a beach towel
- Separate towel for showering

In a labelled bag or bin bag:

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Torch

In your backpack: (This goes on the bus with you)

- Packed lunch for 1st day (in a disposable bag – no lunch boxes please)
- Snap top or screw top bottle (refillable) with drink in (check for leaks and wrap in plastic anyway!)
- Sun hat / woolly hat (school hats are ideal!), sunglasses, sun cream, lip salve
- Camera (N.B. if you want to take one this will be solely your responsibility!)
- Plastic carrier bag in case of mishaps or muddy shoes!
- A couple of elastoplasts in case of blisters
- A small packet of tissues
- A pair of shorts or track suit bottoms (the opposite of what you're wearing)
- Waterproof jacket - need to be 100% waterproof! (ESSENTIAL)
- Inhalers if required (clearly named)
- **NO OTHER MEDICINES, SWEETS, MONEY, PHONES, VALUABLES or ELECTRICAL ITEMS -any found will be removed!**

On departure, what should I wear? Remember that you are representing our school and so dress appropriately. Smart, casual wear is fine. You must wear a school sweatshirt, if you do not have one we will arrange to borrow one for you! No bright slogans or pictures which may cause offence. Be practical!
