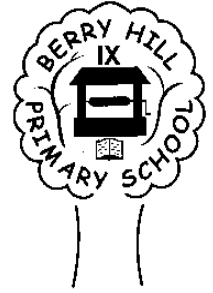

Re **VISIT TO WESTON CIDER FARM**

As part of our topic on animals during terms 4 and 5 this year, I would like to take the children on a visit to Weston Cider Farm to see the new-born lambs and other animals. The date of the visit will be Wednesday 11 March 2020.

The children will travel by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and leaving Much Marcle at 1.30pm for the return to school. The children should be back for the end of the school day at 3.05pm. On the day of the visit, your child will need to wear partial school uniform - Berry Hill School Sweatshirt/Sweat Cardi, Berry Hill School Polo Shirt and regular trousers. Sturdy outdoor footwear/wellies and a warm, waterproof coat is also recommended. Your child will need a packed lunch, drink and snacks from home, preferably in a small rucksack. If you would like to book a school sandwich lunch for the day of the visit, please advise the class teacher by Monday 02.03.2020.

Costs have been estimated at £7.50 per child. This includes return coach costs, and a tour to visit the animals. Children currently in receipt of Pupil Premium will receive a 50% subsidy reducing the cost from £7.50 to £3.75 per child.

A facility for payment has been set up on ParentPay. Please ensure full payment is made on or before Monday 02.03.2020.

In accordance with our new system regarding parental permission for educational visits, please tick the box on ParentPay when making your payment. This constitutes permission for your child to take part on the visit, and replaces the need to return a paper permission slip.

If there have been any changes since the annual Parental Consent Form for School Trips and Offsite Activities was completed earlier this academic year, eg change in medical condition, development of food allergies/intolerances, please advise the class teacher before the date of the visit.
