<p><u>DANGEROUS PARKING IN NINE WELLS ROAD</u></p> <p>Recently, we have been contacted one of our neighbours expressing concern at the dangerous and inconsiderate parking by some along Nine Wells Road, and connected Forestry lanes, at busy drop up and pick up times of the day. As always, it is a small number of repeat offenders who struggle to remember. Please could we draw your attention to the following:</p> <p>Turning into, or stopping in the school entrance – no. Parking/stopping opposite the school entrance – no. Driving into/driving out of the school grounds either side of school start/finish times – no. Parking in the Bus Bay – no. Parking in the Disabled Parking Spaces without the relevant “Blue Badge” – no. Parking or obstructing resident’s driveways and access ways – no.</p> <p>Thank you to all those who already observe the drop off/pick up/parking courtesies.
